At the time of festival this year, automated email to GCI domains was not working. The domains that we believe were affected were: gci.net, ak.net, relayalaska.com, nome.net, alaskan.net, alaskan.com, and anchorageak.net. AFF regrets that if you did not receive your e-newsletter or other AFF emails, that was most likely the reason.

GCI has told us that emails originating at our server, a2plcpnl0931.prod.iad2.secureserver.net, are being dropped due to a network problem. They have not yet been able to diagnose or correct the problem.

The good news is that we are optimistic that we have found another way to send email. If you are an email subscriber, you are likely to receive this newsletter both in paper and by email. Once we are assured the new approach is working, we will revert to your preferred method - either paper or digital.
